


PROGRAMMATIC AXONOMETRICS

We wanted to reinvest the former printing works of the town of Sainte-Marie-aux-Mines, a

historic building where the industrial heritage is still present. Our aim was to design an attractive place to work and meet, with a view to revitalising the town.

As a result, our workspaces are accompanied by a covered market extending onto a square that can accommodate both 'guinguettes' and food-trucks. In addition, we wanted to preserve the industrial character of the site by inviting nature to take possession of the industrial remains. Finally, we have integrated farming areas both inside and outside the building, linked to a shared kitchen open to the city's residents.
